Points to consider:

- 1. **My dad** should be a KC because I can get a loan up to \$2500 per year for college or \$1500 per year for vocational school and I don't have to pay any interest until after I graduate.
- 2. If **my husband** is a KC and dies while we have young children, they will receive \$80 per month from an Orphan Fund plus \$7000 per year up to age 23 for attendance at a Catholic College.
- 3. Deceased KCs are remembered at daily masses at St. Mary's Church in New Haven, Connecticut.
- 4. When **my husband** becomes a KC, both he and I can be enrolled for \$2500 of free life insurance because he is a dues paying member.
- 5. **My KC husband** will be one of 44,250 members in Minnesota and 1.7 million world-wide who are helping to make a difference on issues such as abortion and same sex marriage.
- 6. Statistics show that **KCs are family oriented** and attend mass more often and participate in church functions at a higher rate than non KCs.
- 7. KCs support vocations both vocally and financially and each year in Minnesota they raise over \$50,000 to support education for seminarians, ordained priests and religious brothers and sisters.
