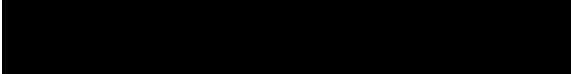


Marathon for Non Public Education

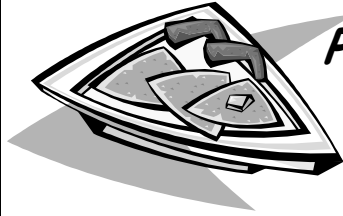
The Marathon for Non Public Education will be held on the morning of October 2nd, 1999. Again we need volunteers to help with traffic control and food distribution for this event.
