Knights of Columbus Free-Throw Contest



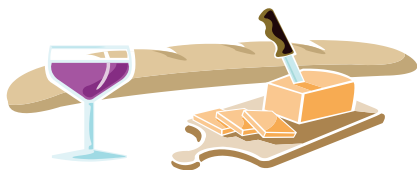

Grand Knight Jeff Block called the meeting to order at 7:55 p.m.

A Prayer and Pledge of Allegiance were recited.

The Roll of Officers was called.

Minutes from the previous meeting, December 6th, 2000, were approved.

Officer's Reports

Grand Knight's Report: Jeff Block

1. A thank you was received from the Joe Kluck family for thoughts and flowers offered by the Knights for the death of Joe's father.
2. A major thank you was offered to Frank Vondrashek and Jim Decker for their work with Christmas Anonymous.
3. A thank you was received for the financial support to rent Mr. & Mrs. Santa suits for the annual night of caroling on the cancer ward at Rochester Methodist Hospital.
4. Thanks to all those who helped assemble and disassemble the stage used for the Holy Spirit School Christmas Concert.
5. The annual Catholic Schools Scholarship Banquet, originally scheduled for March 2nd, 2001, has been indefinitely postponed due to conflict with another Catholic Schools Event. Stay tuned.

Financial Secretary: Jim Decker

Jim reviewed receipts (Christmas ornaments and 2nd/3rd degree) and expenses (2nd/3rd degree, Light up for Christ, flowers, Spirit Run, bibles for 4th grade, parish retreat).

Treasurer's Report: Bill Oertli

Bill presented a detailed year-end report of financial activity for our council. The year-end council balance is \$6683.22. Financial activity was over \$25,000 requiring an annual tax report to be filed.

Director's Reports

Membership & Recruitment: John Lawson

1. A First Degree ceremony was held before this monthly meeting. Four new members were inducted including John McGuire, Co-burn Porter, Brent Johnson and Chris Guibert.
2. Council #11460 will sponsor degree ceremonies March 25th at Lourdes (east door). 1st degree is 10:00 am, with the 2nd and 3rd degrees at noon.

Church: Frank Vondrashek

1. Family Mass is in the early planning stages for April/May.
2. Light Up For Christ was coupled with Embers last month and worked very well.
3. Men's choir always welcomes new members. They perform 3-4 times per year with the next performance on February 11th at the 8:00 am & 9:30 am masses.

Youth Director: DeWayne Gallenberg

A reminder was provided that the annual free throw contest will be held January 21st for boys and girls, ages 10-14 (as of January 1st, 2001). This event is free with trophies awarded to the gender/age group winners. The winners also advance to a district contest and those winners to regionals (Feb 4th & 11th, respectively – both at Lourdes).

Old Business

1. **Pancake breakfast:** Perkins will replace Embers as our sponsor/supplier.
2. **Lite Night with Knights:** The February 8th meeting will be our annual Wine and Cheese Social with spouses or girlfriends. The festivities will be held in the school commons.
3. **Caroling with Cancer Patients:** DeWayne Gallenberg was again our liaison to the Christmas party with Hematology/Oncology inpatients at Methodist Hospital. DeWayne coordinates turning our council's donation into Santa (his and hers) suits. DeWayne reports a very successful evening with these deserving folks.
4. **Closets in school commons:** Brad Brech will set up a day to build storage closets in the commons outside of the kitchen. Plan to volunteer.
5. **Volunteer Opportunity:** Eric Van Norman reported on an opportunity to transport donated excess food from restaurants to charities (e.g. Ronald McDonald House). Contact Eric with questions.
6. **Passion According to Luke:** Resurrection Parish will host a play by this title. Our council will help with up front funding and coordination. A liaison is needed from our council to work with the Resurrection Project Leader.
7. **Awards Banquet Dinner and Dance:** Legends is no longer available for this event so another venue is being sought. Nominations for Knight & Family of the Year are also being solicited.

District Deputies Report

1. A meeting will take place with Ken Mueller and Fr. Schmitz to explore a KC council starting at Resurrection Parish. A similar meeting is taking place at the St. Charles Parish.
2. Of 237 KC councils in Minnesota, more than 130 have not recruited one new member.

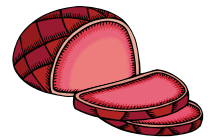
