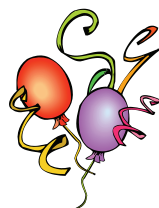
This month we have two Knights:

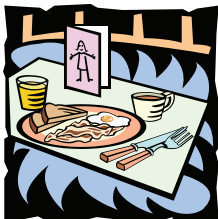
