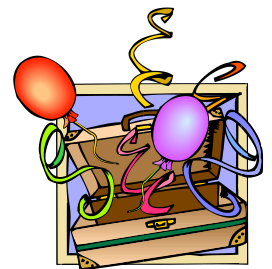
Birthday Celebrations
