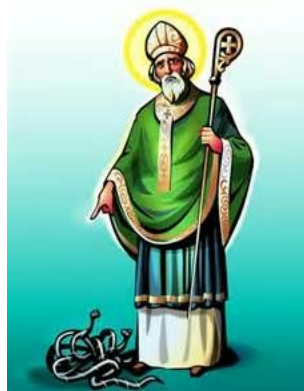
Grand Knight's Message
